

Dear Parents:

After weeks of brainstorming and anticipation, our Summer calendar is set! We have many exciting options for your family, and hope you'll find several that fit your busy Summer schedule.

Looking for a fast paced, creative environment, filled with thematic activities, cooking, and special projects? Discovery School's **Wacky Wednesday** program is just for you! Come for a day filled with theme-based fun. Held from 9:00 to 1:00, Wednesdays are \$30 per session. There is a one-time registration fee of \$10 per family.
