

DISCOVERY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

2021-2022 Key Information

Please read the Discovery School Standing Rules regarding scholarship policies. Below are a few key points to help guide you through the application process:

1. The scholarship application deadline is April 1, 2021. Late and/or incomplete applications will NOT be considered.
2. The Scholarship Committee will review each application submitted regardless of where the applicant falls within the financial guidelines.
3. Scholarship applicants will be notified of their status (whether or not the applicant qualified and, if so, the amount of the award) no later than May 1, 2021.
4. Qualified Kindergarten & First Grade scholarship applicants will be awarded an additional 10% in scholarship funds for the 2021-2022 school year.
5. Acceptance of scholarship funds implies: (a) the applicant's school account must remain in good standing and (b) a reciprocal agreement in which the recipient commits to volunteer 1 hour for every \$50 received in scholarship per month. This volunteer commitment is an addition to the activities for which all Discovery School parents are asked to volunteer, such as class pizza lunches and classroom holiday celebrations. Volunteer hours are evaluated monthly by the Scholarship Committee. Failure to complete volunteer hours will result in revocation of that month's tuition assistance.
6. Scholarship hours will **only** be logged through the Track It Forward website/app.
7. After applications have been processed & Reciprocal Scholarship Agreements have been signed, parents will receive login info and instructions for logging Scholarship hours.
8. Supply Fees, Extended Care Fees, and Cultural Arts Fees are not reduced or paid in any part through the scholarship program.
