

DISCOVERY SCHOOL OF SAN ANTONIO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

Discovery School proudly offers a need-based scholarship program designed to support families within our community who are eligible for tuition assistance. All applications are carefully reviewed by the Discovery School Scholarship Chair using established objective criteria to ensure a fair and consistent process.

Household income is calculated using the most recent pay stubs from all working parents. Income from each pay stub is annualized based on pay frequency (weekly, bi-weekly, semi-monthly, or monthly). Variable income such as tips, commissions, or freelance income is averaged over the most recent weeks.

The total annualized household income is then compared to the 2026 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines to determine the family's Federal Poverty Level percentage. Tuition assistance is awarded on a sliding scale from 12% to 35%, with higher awards granted to families with greater demonstrated financial need. To help offset the higher tuition rates in the upper grades, Kindergarten and First Grade recipients will receive an additional 10% tuition assistance award.

Recipients must maintain a Good Standing School Account and consent to a Reciprocal Agreement to complete monthly service hours corresponding to their scholarship award. Non-compliance with these requirements will result in the forfeiture of tuition assistance for that month. Please note scholarship awards apply only to tuition from September through May, and do not cover Registration, Enrollment, or Activity Fees; Extended Hours (early or late care); Extended Day; or Cultural Arts classes.

Applications should be submitted by May 1, 2026. Families will receive scholarship decisions within thirty (30) days of the application's receipt, allowing ample time to plan financially before non-refundable fees are due in July. We understand that circumstances may change, and we will continue to consider applications submitted after the deadline; however, any awards issued will not be retroactive. Completed applications and required documentation should be submitted electronically to DiscoverySchoolTreasurer@gmail.com. Incomplete applications cannot be processed.
